4 Indians among 10 killed after Russian missile hits ship in Ukraine

Four Indians were among the 10 people killed after an alleged Russian missile strike on a ship, MV Golden Leo, near Ukraine's Odesa on Sunday evening, as per Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) and Ukrainian officials. One other Indian crew member was critically injured in the attack. "India condemns such attacks and reiterates that targeting commercial shipping...is deplorable," MEA stated.
