

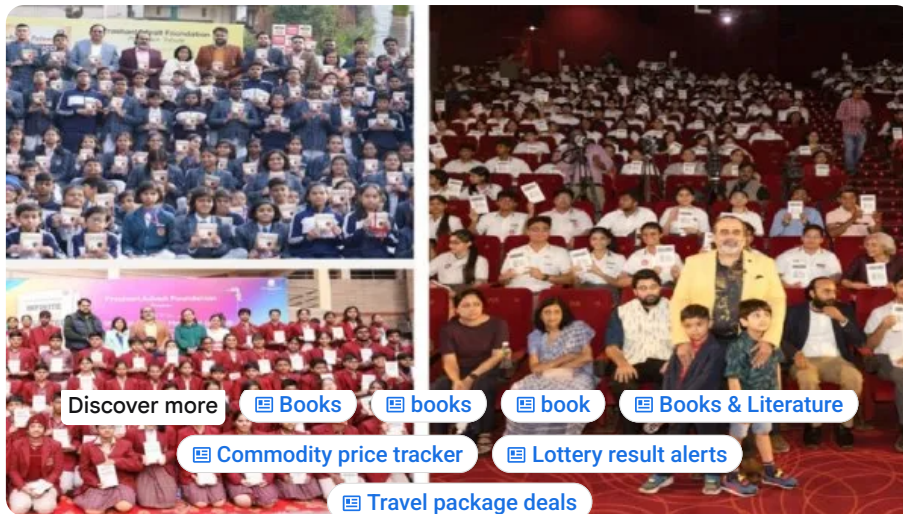

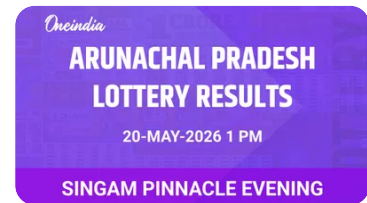
In a recent Aaj Tak interview with Acharya Prashant, whose teachings drive the foundation's work, senior journalist Jai Prakash Pandey was visibly taken aback upon learning just how affordably the foundation was delivering its books.
